WHAT IS THE ANTERIOR APPROACH?

The Anterior Approach is a minimally invasive approach used to perform a Total Hip Replacement. The approach utilises natural planes between muscle groups, so NO muscles are cut during the procedure.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF THE ANTERIOR APPROACH?

No muscles are detached during surgery which can result in:

- Shorter hospital stay
- Shorter rehabilitation
- Reduced risk of dislocation
- Immediate post-operative muscle tone
- Decreased post-operative pain
- Reduced blood loss
- Faster return to daily activities

AM I SUITABLE FOR ANTERIOR APPROACH HIP REPLACEMENT?

The Anterior Approach is suitable for most patients with hip arthritis but some patient's characteristics (anatomy, obesity, previous surgery) may be better suited to other hip approaches. This will be reviewed at the Adelaide Hip Centre.
